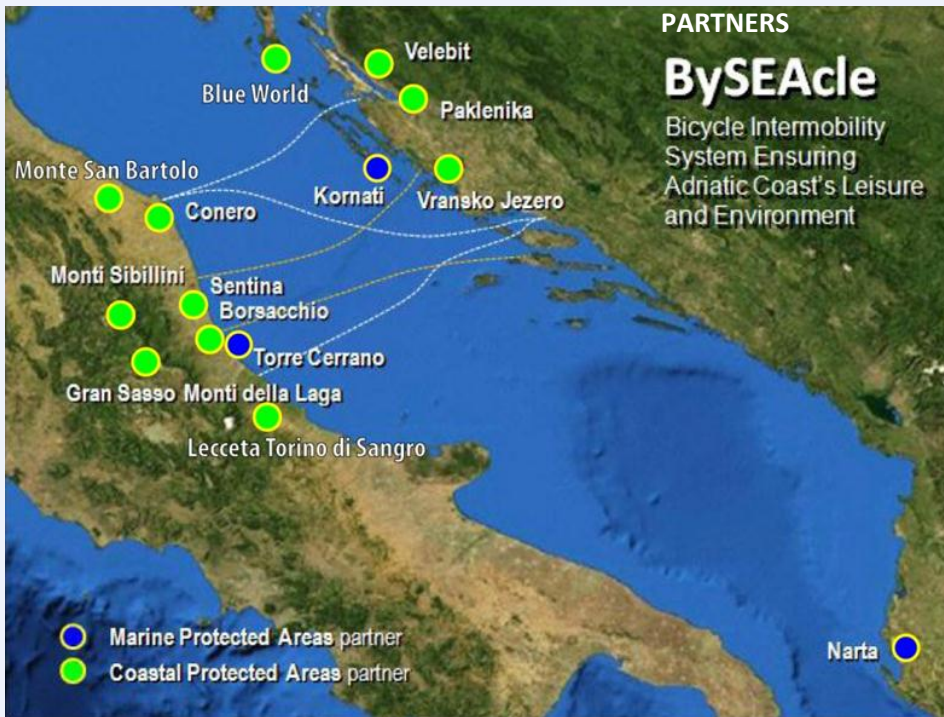


# BySEAcle

Bicycle Intermobility System Ensuring Adriatic Coast's Leisure and Environment



The project “**BySEAcle – Bicycle Intermobility System Ensuring Adriatic Coast’s Leisure and Environment**” has been presented within the **2nd call of the IPA Adriatic Cross-border Cooperation Program 2007-2013**.

The basic idea is to join the Adriatic Protected Areas with sustainable forms of transport by enhancing and promoting touristic sustainable routes with greater references to the cyclo-tourism in the central Adriatic. In particular, such areas characterized by natural-environmental peculiarity should be involved in the use of collective transport solutions with low pollution impact by implementing pilot projects, marketing operations, training, communication and organization of services dedicated to responsible tourism in protected areas.

The project objectives are promoting a network of integrated and intermodal transporting system to ensure sustainable mobility to discover the wonders of Protected Areas in the Adriatic Sea.

This means creating a network of information, communications and available services which will allow the tourists to choose among a wide range of sustainable solutions of transports to move through the various protected areas.

The project BySEAcle was presented from the **Natural Park of Monte San Bartolo** as the Lead Applicant of the project and was originated with the coordination of **AdriaPAN** network.

The project was admitted and ranked in 33<sup>rd</sup> position out of grant.
