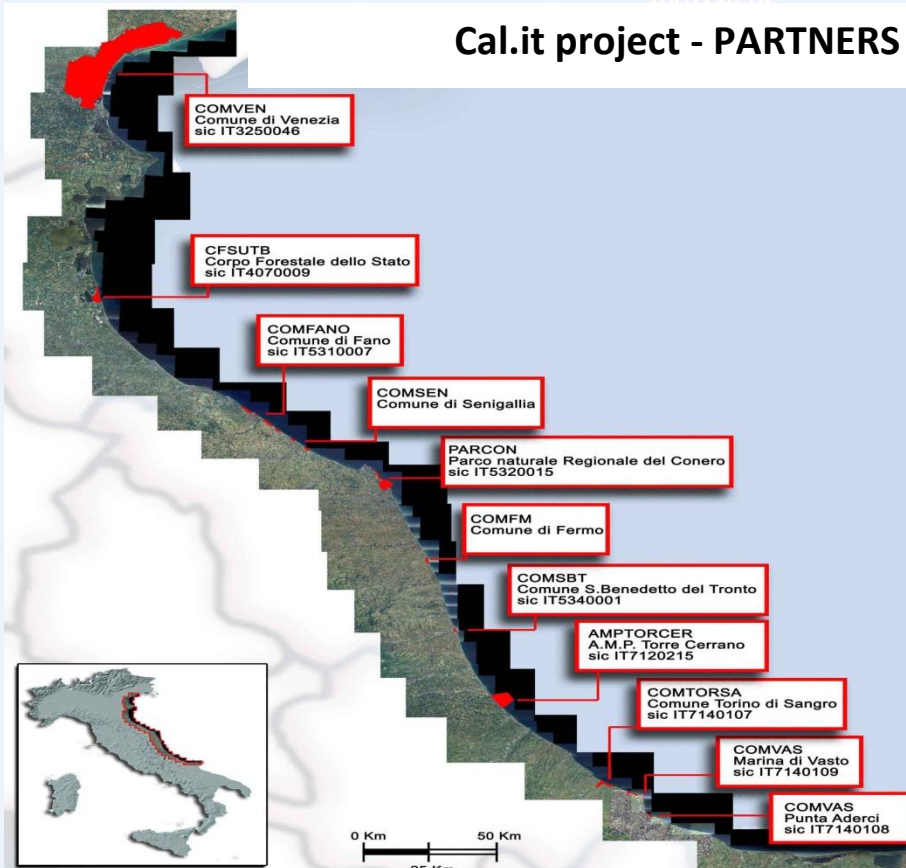

The project **Cal.it - Charadrius alexandrinus in Italy** has been presented within the **2012 call of the Life+ Programme (2007-2013)**. The project is proposed to carry out a series of concrete actions and activities related to the involvement of local actors in all areas of the middle and upper Adriatic (Abruzzo, Marche, Emilia Romagna and Veneto). These activities are considered essential for the staging, migration, wintering, reproduction and conservation of the Kentish Plover (*Charadrius alexandrinus*). The project **C.al.It.** arises as a primarily result to **minimize all factors that have caused and still cause the reduction of the reproductive success of the Charadrius alexandrinus in Adriatic**. The main project activities are the restoration of habitats for feeding and breeding of the Kentish Plover by bioengineering techniques with low environmental impact and the monitoring the interventions effects. The project **Cal.it** was presented by the MPA Torre del Cerrano as the Lead Applicant of the project and was originated with the coordination of **AdriaPAN** network.
