

Project VE.LE.

for Adriatic cycle route Venezia Lecce

The basic idea of the project VE.LE. is to join the Adriatic's area with sustainable forms of transport by enhancing and promoting touristic sustainable routes with greater references to the cyclo-tourism in the central Adriatic.

The project objectives are promoting a network of integrated and intermodal transporting system to ensure sustainable mobility to discover the wonders of protected areas, religious itineraries, historical tours, artistic towns, in the Adriatic Sea.

The project aims to enter the path n. 6 of Bicitalia within Eurovelo. EuroVelo is a project of the European Cyclists' Federation (ECF) to develop a network of high-quality cycling routes connect That the whole continent. The routes can be used by long-distance cycle tourists, as well as by local people making daily journeys.

OBJECTIVES

- to promote economically, environmentally and socially sustainable travel;
- to improve the quality of cycle routes in all participating adriatic countries;
- to promote the uniform signing of cycle routes in accordance with published standards of Eurovelo and Bicitalia;
- to provide Europe-wide information on Ve.Le routes and national cycle routes;
- to support the development of national coordination centres for EuroVelo route and national routes;
- to foster exchange of experience and best practice between Italian regions and European states and regions, stimulating high quality cycle strategies and infrastructure.

This means creating a network of information, communications and available services which will allow the tourists to choose among a wide range of sustainable solutions of transports to move through the various adriatic areas.

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
